

## **Grants - Timelines, Applications and Funding**

The District Grants Chair manages the District Grants process.

The general criteria for project or activity funding is detailed here.

## **District Grants**

Clubs and clusters seeking a District Grant should complete a:

- Proposal for District Grant Project <u>Application Form</u>
- Club Memorandum of Understanding

And forward to the District Grants Chair by 31 May 2017.

Grant approvals will be advised by 31 July 2017. As a general policy, District Grants will require a "dollar for dollar" (1:1) contribution from the applicant club/cluster/

On completion of the project the clubs must submit the **District Grants** Report Form (either completed or as a progress report) by 31 March 2018.

## **Global Grants**

The minimum amount for a project or activity to qualify for a Global grant is US\$30,000. The maximum is US\$400,000.

The Foundation matches club and individual contributions at 50%, while District held Foundation Funds (DDF) are matched at 100%. Applications for Global Grnts are completed using a two-step process involving first a proposal and then an application. The District Grants Chair will assist the drafting of the initial proposal
